## Fee guidelines and what to bring.

Initial consultations take at least 1 hour. This includes taking detailed clinic history from you, a dermatological examination then an explanation of the options for the best way(s) forward, including prognosis and potential costs

The cost is 205-220 depending on the venue. Medications and lab tests are in addition. Standard revisits are normally at 50% discount.

At the Lort Smith, people with pension/health care cards get 25% discount off professional fees. (see next page)

Intradermal testing costs 600-630 depending on the dog size and the venue and this includes sedation
